Additional Requirements	<p>Global talent Invited by Government (E33A):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">→ Proof of guarantee from the national government.→ Invitation from national government agency explaining the purpose of the invitation. <p>Global talent collaborating with the Indonesian Government (E33B):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">→ Evidence which indicates the Foreigner's special expertise, such as:<ul style="list-style-type: none">✓ Certificate in the field of expertise required by the government, or✓ Proof of graduation from one of the list of 100 (one hundred) world's best universities with a grade point average (GPA) of at least 3.5 (three point five).
