



E33 – SECOND HOME VISA

The Second Home Visa (E33) is designed for wealthy individuals, and investors who wish to reside in Indonesia for up to 5 years. Holders can live, travel, and invest in Indonesia but are generally restricted from employment and political activities.

Visa validity	This visa must be used within 90 days from the date of issue.
General Requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> → Valid Passport of at least 6 months. → Proof of living expenses of at least USD 2,000 (two thousand US Dollars) or equivalent. → Recent color photograph. → Statement of commitment (must be accomplished within 90 days after the date of arrival), such as: → Deposit funds in an account under the name of the Foreigner at a state-owned bank with a value of USD 130,000 (one hundred thirty thousand US Dollars), or → Purchase property in Indonesia such as an apartment/house with a value of USD 1.000.000 (one million US Dollars). → ITK/ Permit Number (<i>Applying from within Indonesia</i>)

Document Requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> → Valid Passport of at least 36 months. → Proof of living expenses of at least USD 2,000 (two thousand US Dollars) or equivalent
Requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> → Applicant must be physically present in Indonesia to process KITAS renewal. → Renewal needs to be processed within 1 - 3 months before your KITAS expires.
Price	→ IDR 40.250.000 (Stay 5 years).
